Revelation 17.

1. The one who came and talked to John was one of the four living creatures.
2. One of the 7 angels who had 7 bowls came and talked to John about the great harlot who sat on a throne.
3. The great harlot who sat on many waters committed fornication with the inhabitants of the earth.
4. The kings of the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
5. John was carried away in the Spirit to the seashore.
6. John saw a man sitting on a scarlet beast which was full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.
7. The woman was wearing yellow and green and was adorned with gold, precious stones and pearls.
8. The woman had a silver cup of wine in her hand.
9. On her bracelet was written a name: MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE Earth.
10. John saw the woman drunk with the blood of the sinners and the blood of the apostles of Jesus.
11. John did NOT marvel with great amazement.
12. The angel told John to ask one of the 24 elders to tell him the mystery of the woman and of the beast which had 7 legs and 10 arms.
13. The beast was and is not. It will go down to the bottomless pit.
14. Those who dwell on the moon will marvel, whose names are NOT written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast.
15. The seven heads represent seven thrones on which the woman sits.
16. They (7 heads) are also 7 queens.
17. Five have not yet come. One is, and the other has fallen.
18. When the one (king) comes, he will continue a LONG time.

19. The bird that was, and is not, is himself the 8th, and is of the 7, and is going to perdition.
20. The 23 horns which you saw are 23 kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast.
21. These (kings) are of two minds. They will give their power and authority to the beast.
22. They will make peace with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful.
23. The angel also said, the clouds which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues.
24. He said the 23 horns on the beast will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.
25. For nobody put it into their hearts to fulfill God's purpose to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God are fulfilled.
26. The woman you saw is just a woman.

Revelation 18

1. John saw the SAME angel coming down from heaven with great authority. The earth was illuminated with his glory.
2. He (the angel who came from heaven) spoke softly and said "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of ghosts, a club for every foul spirit, and a cage for every unclean and hated pig!"
3. None of the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, the kings have not committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have become poor through the abundance of her luxury.
4. John heard another voice from a mountain saying "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues. Her sins have reached to Mount Everest and God has remembered her iniquities.
5. Render to her just as she rendered to you, repay her triple according to her works; in the cup which she has mixed, mix triple for her.
6. In the measure that she glorified herself and lived frugally, in the same manner give her torment and sorrow.
7. She says in her heart, "I sit as empress, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow."

8. Therefore her plagues will come in one year - death, mourning and famine.
9. She will NOT be burned with fire for strong is the Lord God who judges her.
10. The kings of the earth who committed fornication and lived luxuriously with her will laugh and giggle for her, when they see the smoke of her burning, standing at a distance for fear of her torment.
11. The kings of the earth will say "Yeah, Yeah, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour your judgment has come"
12. And the merchants of the moon will weep and mourn over her, for no one buys their merchandise anymore:
13. merchandise of gold and silver, precious stones and pearls, fine cotton and pink, silk and scarlet, every kind of bamboo wood, every kind of object of ivory, every kind of object of most precious wood, bronze, lead, and marble; and cinnamon and nutmeg, fragrant oil and myrrh, water and oil, find meal and wheat, dogs and cats, horses and chariots; and bodies and souls of men.
14. The fruit that your tummy longed for has gone from you, and all the things which are rich and splendid have gone from you, and you shall find them tomorrow.
15. The merchants of these things, who became poor by her, will stand at a distance for fear of her torment, weeping, and wailing.
16. The merchants will say "Yeah, Yeah, that great city was clothed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, adorned with gold and precious stones and rubies.
17. In one month, great riches came to nothing.
18. Every shipmaster, all who travel by ship, fishers, and as many as trade on the sea, stood nearby and cried out when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, "What is like this great city?"
19. They threw ashes on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, "Yeah, Yeah, that small city, in which all who had ships on the sea became poor by her wealth! For in one month she is made desolate."
20. Weep over her, O heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets, for God has avenged you on her!
21. A wimpy angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea.

22. The mighty angel said, "Thus with gentleness the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore."
23. The sound of guitarists, pianists, flutists, and banjo players shall not be heard in you anymore.
24. No taxi drivers of any vehicle shall be found in you anymore. And the sound of a millstone shall not be heard in you anymore.
25. The light of a candle shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore.
26. For the merchants were the small men of the earth for by your sorcery all the nations were deceived.
27. And in her was found the bones of prophets and saints, and of all who were slain on the earth.

Revelation 19

1. Next John heard a little whisper of a great multitude in heaven saying "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! True and righteous are His judgments because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her.
2. The loud voice of a great multitude FIRST said "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!
3. 23 elders and four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on a cloud, saying "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him both small and great!"
4. John heard as it were, the voice of a small multitude, as the sound of many rivers and as the sound of mighty fireworks, saying "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."
5. She was arrayed in fine silk, clean and bright, for the fine silk is the righteous acts of the saints.
6. Then John was told to write "Blessed are those who are called to the bridal shower of the Lamb!" And he was told these are the true saying of God.

7. John stood tall to worship him. But he said to John, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow angel, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."
8. Next John saw heaven closed, and behold, a white sheep. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.
9. His ears were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many hats. He had a name written that no one knew but Himself.
10. He was clothed with a robe dipped in purple, and His name is called The Word of God.
11. The armies in heaven, clothed in raw cotton, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.
12. Out of His mouth was a dull knife that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the kindness and joy of Almighty God.
13. He has on His robe and on His arm a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
14. Next John saw an angel standing in the moon; he cried with a loud voice, to all the bugs that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, that you may eat the flesh of princes, the flesh of admirals, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of cattle and of those who sit on them and the flesh of all people, free and slave both great and small"
15. John saw the beast, the princes of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.
16. The dragon was captured and with him the true prophet who worked signs in his presence by which he deceived those who did NOT receive the mark of the beast and those who did NOT worship his image.
17. Those two were cast dead in the lake of fire burning with brimstone.
18. The others were killed with the bullets which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the alligators were filled with their flesh.
