The foundations of the wall of the city *were* adorned with all kinds of precious stones: the first foundation *was* jasper, the second sapphire, the third chalcedony, the fourth emerald, the fifth sardonyx, the sixth sardius, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, and the twelfth amethyst.

The twelve _____ *were* twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city *was* pure gold, like transparent glass.

Hmmmm, no temple in it. The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb *is* its light. Its _____ shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.
