Stars in Revelation

1. 2.28 Those who overcome in Philadelphia would be given the **morning star**.
2. 8.10-11 (3rd trumpet)....A great **star** fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. The name of the star is Wormwood.
3. 9.1....(5th trumpet, 1st woe)....I saw a **star** fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit - where the locusts lived ☹

Monsters/Beast/Dragons in Revelation

The Locusts from the Bottomless Pit (chapter 9)

- The locusts came out of the smoke of the bottomless pit
- They were given power as the scorpions of the earth have power
- They were commanded NOT to harm the grass or any green thing or any tree
- They were ONLY to harm those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.
- They were NOT given authority to kill, but to torment for five months
- The shape of the locusts was like horses prepared for battle.
- On their heads were crowns of something like gold
- Their faces were like the faces of men.
- They had hair like women's hair
- Their teeth were like lions' teeth.
- They had breastplates like breastplates of iron
- The sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots with many horses running into battle.
- They had tails like scorpions and there were stings in their tails
- Their power was to hurt men five months.
- They were associated with the first woe (trumpet 5)

The 200,000,000 horses (also chapter 9)

- Those who sat on them had breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow
- The heads of the horses were like the heads of lions
- Out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and brimstone
- By these three plagues (fire, smoke, brimstone) a third of mankind was killed
- Their power was in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents, having heads; and with them they do harm.
- The rest of mankind, who were NOT killed by these plagues did NOT repent of the works of their hands
- They were associated with the second woe (trumpet 6)

The beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit (chapter 11)

- It will kill the two witnesses after they finish their testimony

The dragon (chapter 12)

- Another sign appeared in heaven, a great fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns
- He had 7 diadems on his heads
- His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth.
- He wanted to devour the Child as soon as it was born.
- War broke out in heaven; Michael and his angels fought with the dragon;
- The dragon and his angels did not prevail
- A place was NOT found for them in heaven any longer.
- The great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan
- He deceives the whole world
- He was cast to earth
- The dragon (when he saw he had been cast to earth) persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male child.
- The serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood
- The dragon was enraged with the woman and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

The Beast from the Sea (chapter 13)

- John saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns.
- He had on his horns 10 crowns and on his heads a blasphemous name
- The beast was like a leopard
- His feet were like the feet of a bear
- His mouth was like the mouth of a lion
- The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority
- One of his heads looked as if it had been mortally wounded and his deadly wound was healed.
- The world marveled and followed the beast.
- The world worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast and they worshiped the beast.
- He was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies
- He was given authority to continue for 42 months.
- He blasphemed against God, His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven.
- It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them.
- Authority was given to him over every tribe, tongue, and nation
- All on earth will worship him, whose names have NOT been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

The Beast from the Earth (Chapter 13 also)

- Another beast came up out of the earth.
- He had 2 horns like a lamb.
- He spoke like a dragon.
- He exercised all the authority of the first beast in his presence
- He causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound has healed
- He performs great signs; he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in sight of men
- He deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs
- He tells those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived
- He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would NOT worship the image of the beast to be killed.
- He caused all (small and great, rich and poor, free and slave) to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast or the number of his name.
- The number of the beast is 666. It is the number of a man

The Scarlet Beast (chapter 17)

- John was carried away in the Spirit into the wilderness. He saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast.
- It was full of names of blasphemy having seven heads and 10 horns
- The beast was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit and go to perdition.
- Those who dwell on the earth will marvel, whose names are NOT written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.
- The beast that was, and is not, is himself also the 8th (king), and is of the 7, and is going to perdition
- The 10 horns which you saw are 10 kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast.
- The ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire.

The beast (haven't positively figured out which one, dragon/beast of earth/beast of sea/scarlet beast?)

- John saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.
- The beast was captured and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.
- These two (beast and false prophet) were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- An angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.
- When the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. They went up on the breadth of the earth, and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them. The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. They will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
