### Leviticus Begin with Chapter 6 Vs 8

# The Law of the Burnt Offering

<sup>8</sup> Then the LORD spoke to \_\_\_\_\_\_, saying, <sup>9</sup> "Command Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the law of the burnt offering: The burnt offering shall be on the hearth upon the \_\_\_\_\_\_ all night until morning, and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it.
<sup>10</sup> And the priest shall put on his \_\_\_\_\_\_ garment, and his linen trousers he shall put on his body, and take up the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the burnt offering which the \_\_\_\_\_\_ has consumed on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar. <sup>11</sup> Then he shall take off his \_\_\_\_\_\_, put on other garments, and carry the ashes outside the \_\_\_\_\_\_ to a clean place. <sup>12</sup> And the fire on the altar shall be kept \_\_\_\_\_\_ on it; it shall not be put out. And the priest shall burn on it the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the shall always be burning on the altar; it shall \_\_\_\_\_\_ go out.

### The Law of the Grain Offering

<sup>14</sup> 'This *is* the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the grain offering: The sons of Aaron shall offer it on the altar before the LORD. <sup>15</sup> He shall take from it his handful of the fine \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the grain offering, with its \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, and all the frankincense which *is* on the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ offering, and shall burn *it* on the altar *for* a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ aroma, as a memorial to the LORD. <sup>16</sup> And the remainder of it \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and his sons shall eat; with unleavened bread it shall be eaten in a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ place; in the court of the tabernacle of meeting they shall eat it. <sup>17</sup> It shall \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ be baked with \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, I have given it *as* their portion of My offerings made by fire; it *is* most \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, like the sin offering and the trespass offering. <sup>18</sup> All the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ among the children of Aaron may eat it. *It shall be* a statute \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in your generations concerning the offerings made by \_\_\_\_\_\_\_

<sup>19</sup> And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <sup>20</sup> "This is the offering of Aaron and his sons, which they shall offer to the LORD, beginning on the \_\_\_\_\_ when he is anointed: one-tenth of an ephah of fine flour as a daily grain offering, half of it in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and half of it at \_\_\_\_\_. <sup>21</sup> It shall be made in a \_\_\_\_\_ with oil. When it is mixed, you shall bring it in. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ pieces of the grain offering you shall offer for a sweet aroma to the LORD.
<sup>22</sup> The priest from among his \_\_\_\_\_\_, who is anointed in his place, shall offer it. It is a statute forever to the LORD. It shall be \_\_\_\_\_\_ burned. <sup>23</sup> For every grain offering for the priest shall be wholly burned. It shall \_\_\_\_\_\_ be eaten."

# The Law of the Sin Offering

<sup>24</sup> Also the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <sup>25</sup> "Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'This is the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is \_\_\_\_\_\_, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD. It is most holy. <sup>26</sup> The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. In a \_\_\_\_\_\_ place it shall be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of meeting. <sup>27</sup> Everyone who touches its \_\_\_\_\_\_ must be holy.<sup>[b]</sup> And when its \_\_\_\_\_\_ is sprinkled on any garment, you shall wash that on which it was sprinkled, in a holy place. <sup>28</sup> But the earthen vessel in which it is \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ shall be \_\_\_\_\_\_. ### The Law of the Trespass Offering

It *is* most holy. <sup>7</sup> The \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ offering *is* like the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ offering; *there is* one \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ for them both: the priest who makes atonement with it shall have *it*. <sup>8</sup> And the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the burnt offering which he has offered. <sup>9</sup> Also every grain offering that is baked in the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and all that is prepared in the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ pan, or in a pan, shall be the priest's who offers it. <sup>10</sup> Every grain offering, *whether* mixed with \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, shall belong to all the sons of Aaron, to one *as* much as the other.

### The Law of Peace Offerings

<sup>11</sup> 'This *is* the law of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of peace offerings which he shall offer to the LORD: <sup>12</sup> If he offers it for a \_\_\_\_\_\_, then he shall offer, with the sacrifice of thanksgiving, unleavened \_\_\_\_\_\_ mixed with oil, unleavened \_\_\_\_\_\_ anointed with oil, or cakes of blended \_\_\_\_\_\_ mixed with oil. <sup>13</sup> Besides the cakes, *as* his offering he shall offer leavened \_\_\_\_\_\_ with the sacrifice of thanksgiving of his peace offering. <sup>14</sup> And from it he shall offer one \_\_\_\_\_\_ from each offering *as* a \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering to the LORD. It shall belong to the priest who \_\_\_\_\_\_ the blood of the peace offering.

<sup>15</sup> 'The flesh of the sacrifice of his \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering for thanksgiving shall be eaten the \_\_\_\_\_\_ day it is offered. He shall not leave any of it until morning. <sup>16</sup> But if the sacrifice of his offering *is* a \_\_\_\_\_\_ or a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ offering, it shall be eaten the same day that he offers his sacrifice; but on the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ day the remainder of it also may be eaten; <sup>17</sup> the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the flesh of the sacrifice on the third day must be burned with \_\_\_\_\_\_. <sup>18</sup> And if *any* of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offering is eaten at all on the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to him who offers it, and the person who eats of it shall \_\_\_\_\_\_ guilt.

<sup>19</sup> 'The \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ that touches any unclean thing shall not be eaten. It shall be burned with fire. And as for the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ flesh, all who are clean may eat of it. <sup>20</sup> But the \_\_\_\_\_\_ who eats the flesh of the sacrifice of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering that *belongs* to the LORD, while he is \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, that person shall be \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ from his people. <sup>21</sup> Moreover the person who \_\_\_\_\_\_ any unclean thing, *such as* human uncleanness, *an* unclean animal, or any abominable unclean thing, <sup>[d]</sup> and who \_\_\_\_\_\_ the flesh of the sacrifice of the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the LORD, that person shall be cut off from his \_\_\_\_\_\_.'''

### Fat and Blood May Not Be Eaten

<sup>22</sup> And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <sup>23</sup> "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'You shall not eat any \_\_\_\_\_, of \_\_\_\_\_ or sheep or goat. <sup>24</sup> And the fat of an animal that \_\_\_\_\_\_ *naturally*, and the fat of what is torn by \_\_\_\_\_\_ beasts, may be used in any other way; but you shall by no means \_\_\_\_\_\_ it. <sup>25</sup> For whoever eats the fat of the animal of which men offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, the person who eats *it* shall be cut off from his \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in any of your dwellings, *whether* of \_\_\_\_\_\_ or beast. <sup>27</sup> Whoever eats any blood, that person shall be cut off from his people.'"

### The Portion of Aaron and His Sons

<sup>28</sup> Then the LORD spoke to \_\_\_\_\_\_, saying, <sup>29</sup> "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'He who offers the sacrifice of his \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering to the LORD shall bring his offering to the LORD from the sacrifice of his peace offering. <sup>30</sup> His own \_\_\_\_\_\_ shall bring the offerings made by \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the LORD. The fat with the breast he shall bring, that the breast may be waved as a \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering before the LORD. <sup>31</sup> And the priest shall burn the \_\_\_\_\_ on the altar, but the \_\_\_\_\_\_ shall be Aaron's and his sons'. <sup>32</sup> Also the right \_\_\_\_\_\_ you shall give to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ as a heave offering from the sacrifices of your peace offerings. <sup>33</sup> He among the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of Aaron, who offers the blood of the peace offering and the \_\_\_\_\_\_, shall have the right thigh for *his* part. <sup>34</sup> For the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the wave offering and the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the heave offering I have taken from the children of Israel, from the sacrifices of their peace offerings, and I have given them to Aaron the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and to his sons from the children of Israel by a statute forever.'"

<sup>35</sup> This *is* the consecrated portion for Aaron and his sons, from the offerings made by \_\_\_\_\_\_ to the LORD, on the day when *Moses* presented them to minister to the LORD as priests. <sup>36</sup> The LORD commanded this to be given to them by the children of Israel, on the day that He anointed them, by a statute forever throughout their \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>37</sup> This *is* the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the burnt offering, the grain offering, the sin offering, the trespass offering, the consecrations, and the sacrifice of the peace offering, <sup>38</sup> which the LORD commanded Moses on Mount Sinai, on the day when He commanded the children of Israel to offer their offerings to the LORD in the Wilderness of Sinai.

### Aaron and His Sons Consecrated

8 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: <sup>2</sup> "Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments, the anointing oil, a \_\_\_\_\_\_ as the sin offering, two rams, and a basket of unleavened bread; <sup>3</sup> and gather all the congregation together at the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the tabernacle of meeting."

<sup>4</sup> So Moses did as the LORD commanded him. And the congregation was gathered together at the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the tabernacle of \_\_\_\_\_\_. <sup>5</sup> And Moses said to the congregation, "This *is* what the LORD commanded to be done."

<sup>6</sup> Then Moses brought Aaron and his sons and washed them with \_\_\_\_\_\_. <sup>7</sup> And he put the tunic on him, girded him with the sash, clothed him with the \_\_\_\_\_\_, and put the ephod on him; and he girded him with the intricately woven \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the ephod, and with it tied *the ephod* on him. <sup>8</sup> Then he put the \_\_\_\_\_\_ on him, and he put the Urim and the Thummim<sup>[e]</sup> in the breastplate. <sup>9</sup> And he put the \_\_\_\_\_\_ on his head. Also on the turban, on its front, he put the golden \_\_\_\_\_\_, the holy crown, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

<sup>10</sup> Also Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and all that was in it, and consecrated them. <sup>11</sup> He sprinkled some of it on the altar \_\_\_\_\_\_ times, anointed the altar and all its utensils, and the laver and its \_\_\_\_\_, to consecrate them. <sup>12</sup> And he poured some of the anointing oil on Aaron's \_\_\_\_\_ and anointed him, to consecrate him.

<sup>13</sup> Then Moses brought Aaron's sons and put \_\_\_\_\_ on them, girded them with \_\_\_\_\_, and put \_\_\_\_\_ on them, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

<sup>14</sup> And he brought the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering. Then Aaron and his sons laid their \_\_\_\_\_\_ on the head of the bull for the sin offering, <sup>15</sup> and \_\_\_\_\_\_ killed *it*. Then he took the blood, and put *some* on the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the altar all around with his \_\_\_\_\_\_, and purified the altar. And he poured the blood at the base of the altar, and consecrated it, to make atonement for it. <sup>16</sup> Then he took all the \_\_\_\_\_\_ that *was* on the entrails, the \_\_\_\_\_\_ lobe *attached to* the liver, and the two kidneys with their \_\_\_\_\_\_, and Moses burned *them* on the altar. <sup>17</sup> But the bull, its \_\_\_\_\_\_, its \_\_\_\_\_\_, and its \_\_\_\_\_\_, he burned with fire outside the \_\_\_\_\_\_, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

<sup>18</sup> Then he brought the \_\_\_\_\_\_ as the \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering. And Aaron and his sons laid their hands on the head of the ram, <sup>19</sup> and Moses killed *it*. Then he sprinkled the blood all around on the altar. <sup>20</sup> And he cut the ram into pieces; and Moses burned the \_\_\_\_\_\_, the pieces, and the fat. <sup>21</sup> Then he washed the entrails and the \_\_\_\_\_\_ in \_\_\_\_\_. And Moses burned the whole ram on the altar. It *was* a burnt sacrifice for a \_\_\_\_\_\_ aroma, an offering made by fire to the LORD, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

<sup>22</sup> And he brought the second \_\_\_\_\_, the ram of \_\_\_\_\_. Then Aaron and his sons laid their hands on the head of the ram, <sup>23</sup> and Moses killed it. Also he took some of its blood and put it on the tip of Aaron's right \_\_\_\_\_, on the \_\_\_\_\_ of his right hand, and on the big \_\_\_\_\_\_ of his right foot. <sup>24</sup> Then he brought Aaron's sons. And Moses put some of the blood on the tips of their right ears, on the thumbs of their right hands, and on the big toes of their \_\_\_\_\_ feet. And Moses sprinkled the \_\_\_\_\_ all around on the altar. <sup>25</sup> Then he took the fat and the fat \_\_\_\_\_, all the fat that was on the entrails, the fatty lobe attached to the liver, the two kidneys and their fat, and the right \_\_\_\_\_; <sup>26</sup> and from the \_\_\_\_\_ of unleavened bread that was before the LORD he took \_\_\_\_\_\_ unleavened cake, a cake of bread anointed with oil, and one \_\_\_\_\_, and put them on the fat and on the \_\_\_\_\_ thigh; <sup>27</sup> and he put all these in Aaron's \_\_\_\_\_\_ and in his sons' hands, and \_\_\_\_\_\_ them as a wave offering before the LORD.<sup>28</sup> Then Moses took them \_\_\_\_\_ their hands and burned them on the altar, on the burnt offering. They were \_\_\_\_\_ offerings for a sweet aroma. That was an offering made by fire to the LORD.<sup>29</sup> And Moses took the \_\_\_\_\_

and waved it as a \_\_\_\_\_\_ offering before the LORD. It was Moses' \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the ram of consecration, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

<sup>30</sup> Then Moses took some of the anointing \_\_\_\_\_\_ and some of the \_\_\_\_\_\_ which *was* on the altar, and sprinkled *it* on Aaron, on his \_\_\_\_\_\_, on his sons, and on the garments of his sons with him; and he consecrated Aaron, his garments, his sons, and the garments of his sons with him.

<sup>31</sup> And Moses said to Aaron and his sons, "\_\_\_\_\_\_ the flesh at the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the tabernacle of \_\_\_\_\_\_, and eat it there with the \_\_\_\_\_\_ that is in the basket of consecration offerings, as I commanded, saying, 'Aaron and his sons shall eat it.'
<sup>32</sup> What remains of the flesh and of the bread you shall \_\_\_\_\_\_ with fire. <sup>33</sup> And you shall \_\_\_\_\_\_ go outside the door of the tabernacle of meeting for seven days, until the days of your consecration are ended. For seven \_\_\_\_\_\_ he shall consecrate you.
<sup>34</sup> As he has done this day, so the LORD has commanded to do, to make \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ for you. <sup>35</sup> Therefore you shall stay at the door of the tabernacle of meeting \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_\_ for seven days, and keep the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ of the LORD, so that you may \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ die; for so I have been commanded." <sup>36</sup> So Aaron and his sons did \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ the things that the LORD had commanded by the hand of Moses.
