There were 10 of us. 9 forgot our manners. Describe us

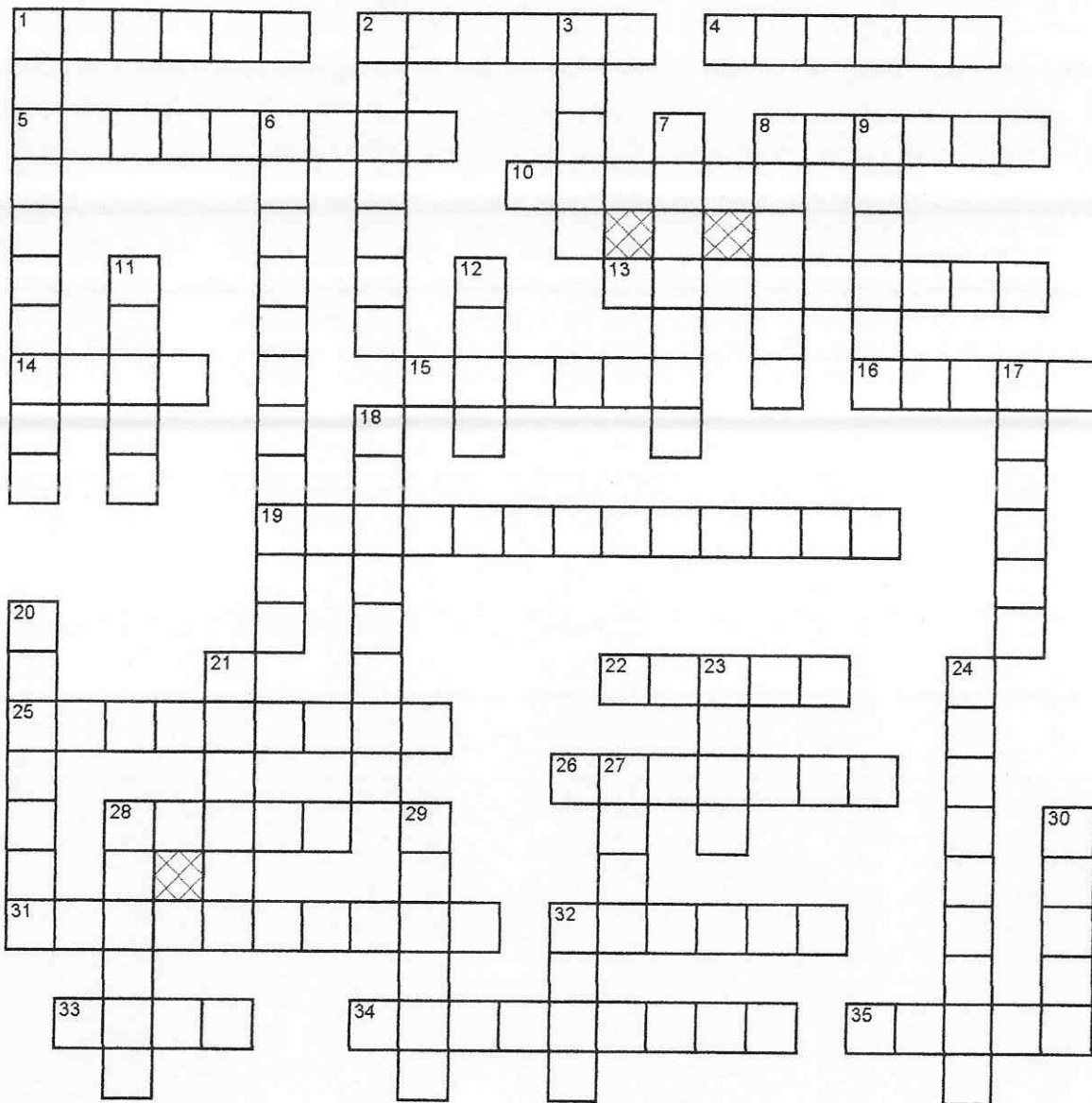
I was a chief tax collector. I was rich. I was short.
